You will find an added attachment to this week's parent message that speaks to Emergency Closures of Schools and the procedures that will be followed in the event that our school is closed due to inclement weather. After last week's weather and our weather today, it seems prudent to get this out right away.

The **Holyoake DRUMBEAT Program** is an evidence-based curriculum used widely across Australia, and other countries that explores relationship issues central to healthy relationships and lifestyles. This fun and interactive program has a structured format that extends across 10 one-hour sessions.

The drum circle reflects a <u>community</u> and provides a safe place to explore human relationships and practice healthy social interaction. Sessions are structured and have specific themes that explore issues such as peer pressure, dealing with emotions, friendships, risk taking, identity, social responsibility & teamwork. The DRUMBEAT program is primarily an experiential process that does not rely heavily on conversation.

Jennifer Rowe (Rocky View's Family School Liaison) will be joined by a WH Croxford staff to deliver this beneficial program for 10 weeks, to a small group of high school students.
