	<b>Music</b>	Students will be given opportunities to: express their ideas through creation of their own sound composition, develop an understanding of music of various cultures through participation and critical reflection.

	<b>Art</b>	Students will create art by using a variety of media (painting, sculpture, pottery, mixed media). They will develop their artistic, technical and critical skills as they explore visual expression share their thoughts and ideas with others.
	<b>Business Innovation</b>	Interested in running business? Have an entrepreneurial spirit? Explore these skills deeper in the business center. You will create and operate a business venture
	<b>Cosmetology</b>	Students develop increased appreciation for the significance of personal grooming in various life situations, as well as the knowledge and skills required to maintain a personal health and safety plan.
	<b>Construction</b>	Students develop basic hand tool and production skills to transform common building materials safely into useful products.
	<b>Dance</b>	Students will explore a variety of dance styles.
	<b>Digital Arts</b>	Learn the basic principles of photography/videography and apply skills to creative projects and storytelling.
	<b>Drama</b>	Students will learn to communicate in various ways and work creatively with others as they discover dramatic expression.
	<b>Fashion Studies</b>	Students discover the world of fashion illustration and learn to sketch a croquis, incorporate simple gestures and apply these skills to create fashion illustrations.
	<b>Foods</b>	Students learn safe and sanitary food handling procedures, equipment care, comprehension of recipes and the importance of efficient work habits.
	<b>French</b>	Being able to understand and use French is an important aspect of being a Canadian and a global citizen. By learning French, students are able to develop the necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes needed to communicate in a variety of real-life contexts. No previous French instruction is required.
	<b>Mechanics</b>	Students research, design, build and test a model of transportation vehicle using a simple power source, common materials and tools.
	<b>Outdoor Education</b>	Students develop the attitudes, skills and knowledge related to wildlife and ecosystems, and an understanding for the need to manage wildlife
	<b>Spanish</b>	Develop the necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes needed to communicate in a variety of real-life contexts. No previous Spanish instruction is required.
	<b>Sports Enrichment</b>	Students apply basic training and movement principles to health-related and performance-related components of sports.
	<b>Robotics</b>	Students explore the world of robotics and program their own robot to do various tasks. Students are introduced to several different coding languages.
