Easter Seals is pleased to partner with Scotia Bank, through its ScotiaRISE commitment, to offer financial grants and mentorship opportunities to students in Alberta who are currently in or who will be entering high school in Fall 2024. The grant and mentorship opportunity is intended for any student with a disability who is currently enrolled in or entering high school in Fall 2024. The scholarship's objective is to reduce financial barriers for the student as they complete high school and assist them in preparing for a successful transition into post-secondary education or entry into the workforce. The grants are valued at **\$1000** per student. Students can apply the grant funding toward purchasing laptops, learning aids or other specialized/adaptive learning equipment, learning software, or tutoring and other costs required for school.

Phyllis Davidson Scholarship

Phyllis Davidson Easter Seals Scholarship was created in loving memory of Phyllis Davidson and offers post-secondary academic scholarships to students living with physical disabilities.

Each year one \$20,000 scholarship will be awarded to a successful applicant at **\$5,000** per academic year for four years.

An additional \$5,000* is available for extraordinary educational expenses for the student related to their disability. **More information will be available to successful applicants.*

Please note: Phyllis Davidson Easter Seals Scholarship funds are to be used only on educational expenses (i.e. tuition, books, technology, etc.).

To qualify, you must be a current student or candidate for admission into a post-secondary institution within Alberta, living with a physical disability. Students should be attending a minimum of two courses per semester, pursuing an academic or professional program leading to a degree or diploma.

Norman Denoon Scholarship

Established in memory of Norman Denoon, the Easter Seals Alberta Norman Denoon Memorial Scholarship offers post-secondary academic scholarships to students living with disabilities that have made a significant contribution through volunteerism or advocacy.

Two scholarships of **\$5,000** per school year are given to qualified students working towards a post-secondary program within Alberta.

Please note: Scholarship funds are to be used only on educational expenses (i.e. tuition, books, technology, etc.).

To qualify, you must be a current student or candidate for admission into a post-secondary institution within Alberta, living with a disability. Students should be attending a minimum of two courses per semester, pursuing an academic or professional program leading to a degree or diploma.
