Trustee report:

Fred Burley -

New school updates Langdon, Sarah Thompson.

1.18 Million supplemental growth grant from the gov – one time payment spread over 12 months. still 3.3 Million short.

A delegation made a presentation to RVS Board regarding books on sexuality courses they didn't approve of, but the board has proved those books aren't in RVS and everything follows the AB Gov curriculum.

Students from W.G Murdoch constructed a museum of Human rights and did a really great job with it, parents came and went through the museum.

Student transportation is continuing to grow. 12660 students take the bus in RVS.

Indigenous learning dept is doing a great job, providing resources and knowledge. Update on the cold snap that closed schools, always having someone on site incase students show up. Just trying to keep everyone safe.

Ratified agreement with the ATA. Open houses for continuous growth are going well, last one is tomorrow at Burt Church.

The new announcements that the Gov has released we don't know what that means.

Teacher Report: Amanda Jackson

New teacher with Croxford, in Learning Support. Introduction. She gets to see everything, gets to see what's going in classrooms, working with complex students, working with talents and strengths.

From the questions: Learning support is getting 5 iPads. Croxford doesn't have a sensory room due to space but theres sensory bins and certain spaces for certain students.

Administration report:

AB ED surveys are now out: Grade 10's Parents will get a package with a code. Surveys go until the beginning of March. Parents are usually difficult to reach for this survey, it was included in the Croxford connection.

New RVS Website, New school websites, Croxford approx. April 28<sup>th</sup>. New websites will be a bit leaner, will contain the most important information.

PBIS – positive behaviour and supports building a Matrix. Core values have been determined: Welcome, respectful, safe and caring. Next step is gathering feedback on what does those words mean to students.

At Parent teacher interviews and open house they will get more information on this. Open house for incoming grade 9's

Course selection and timeline: will be doing digitally. Making presentations on the courses that will be available. Will be doing engagements at other schools also instead of bringing students to Croxford.

Questions: If there's changes and there is no grade 9's next year -D- operating as if there will be grade 9's.

School is preparing for either scenario.

As it stands right now, Croxford cannot accommodate with any further portables. Even with pulling out grade 9's we will be at 100% If we bring in the grade 9' s we will be at 120%
