- Math 20-1 or Math 20-2 or Math 20-3
- Science 20 or 24 or Biology 20 or Chemistry 20 or Physics 20
- Physical Education 10 (3 or 5 credits)
- Career and Life Management (CALM) (3 credits)

Earn 10 credits in any combination from:

- Career and Technology Studies (CTS)
- Fine Arts
- Second Languages
- Physical Education 20 and/or 30
- Knowledge and Employability occupational courses
- Registered Apprenticeship Program Courses

Earn 10 credits in any 30-level course

(in addition to 30 level English and 30 level Social Studies), including:

- 30 level Mathematics, Science, Fine Arts, Languages, CTS, or Physical Education
