W. H. Croxford High School Graduation Requirements

To participate in the WHC Commencement Ceremony students must have completed, or be enrolled in, a program that will enable them to earn a diploma by June 30th of the graduating year. To determine this, **we require that students have completed 80 credits by February 1st and be enrolled in sufficient courses by April 1st of the current school year to graduate.** Individual circumstances may be considered. **All School Fees should be addressed. Students must also be in 'good standing' (ie. no chronic absenteeism throughout the year or suspensions during grad week).**

Students on any WeConnect/Distance Education/Work Place Learning Programs must be passing and have completed half of the course/credits by the end of term three in order to qualify for the WHC Graduation list.

Students do not automatically qualify to graduate. Students must apply to take part in the Commencement Ceremony. This application form must be completed and submitted to the Grade 12 Counsellor in order to qualify for evaluation to participate in graduation ceremonies.
